

# Family Treasure Hunt

What to do:

1. Cut out these clues, adding more of your own if you can think of good hiding places in your house. Cut off the pictures if this will make it too easy, or leave them on to help younger children join in.
2. Find something to be the "treasure", maybe some biscuits, left over Easter chocolate, or be creative and draw a lovely picture of your family.
3. Keep clue 1 to give out at the start. Put clue 2 in the place described in clue 1 (with the forks).
4. Put out all your clues in the right order. Remember that each clue tells the reader where to go next.
5. In the last spot put the poem and your "treasure".
6. Now you can give clue 1 to your family and watch them search for the treasure.
